Secondary Teacher Education

Proposed Program Revisions

January 2008

The following revisions are proposed to strengthen our secondary teacher education program.

- 1. Move the special education component of Block I to Block II. Rationale: Two instructors are currently assigned to teach three content areas Educational Psychology, Multicultural Education, and Special Education. The change would allow each content area to have a 3-credit course. Special education focuses on differentiated instruction, which is better aligned with a methods course.
- 2. <u>Move Content Literacy from Block II to Block I</u>. The special education course and the content literacy course will be "flip-flopped." Content Literacy will be offered in the evening.
- 3. <u>Keep the total number of credits the same.</u> This will be done by charging a field experience fee for Blocks II and III instead of course credit and dropping the field experience for specialty methods.
- 4. Move Block II class time from the afternoon to the morning. Students need time to be in classrooms during the day. The afternoon time restricts access because middle schools and high schools end their day by 2:30 pm.
