RE: K-12 (All School Settings) FOREIGN (WORLD) LANGUAGES 2008

With the invitation of the INDOE to institute a K-12 certification program, I am moving forward on changes in the academic requirements to make this a reality (see proposal below).

Currently the Foreign Language Education Program requires a total of 124 credits, minimum to graduate. The specific languages requirements vary between 36-39 credits. Total program specified 122-125 credits of actual program requirements for students depending on language choice. Students with 36 credits in content will need to add 2 credits of free electives to meet the 124 Bachelor of Science minimum.
