## Process for Selecting the Chair of the Department of Educational Leadership and Policy Studies

(revised by ELPS on January 21, 2011)

- 1. The new department chair for ELPS shall be selected from within the current department faculty.
- 2. The current ELPS department chair will send an e-mail message seeking nominations from all IUB and IUPUI ELPS faculty members (including part-time, clinical, and visiting faculty). All tenured faculty members in the department are eligible for nomination. Faculty members may self-nominate.
- 3. Faculty members may not remove their names from potential nomination.
- 4. Nominations will be returned to the Executive Associate Dean, IUB, who will prepare a ballot listing the names of those who have been nominated. Ballots will be sent to all full-time ELPS faculty members who will be asked to rank their top three preferences among all nominees. Ballots will be returned to the Executive Associate Dean for tabulation.
- 5. The results of the tabulation will be shared with the current ELPS chair, who will report the findings to the faculty members in the department. If a clear ranking of the top three to five candidates does not emerge from the balloting process, the entire faculty will meet to prepare a ranked list of at least three nominees to recommend to the Dean.
