Doctoral Minor in College Pedagogy August 2015

Students interested in the College Pedagogy minor should contact the Higher Education and Student Affairs program at hesa@indiana.edu to be assigned a minor advisor. A student minoring in College Pedagogy will work with her/his minor advisor to determine which courses to take to satisfy the requirements of the minor. A student needs a total of 9 or 12 credits for this minor depending on the requirements of her/his program of study (e.g., in the School of Education EdD students need 9 credits and PhD students need 12 credits). Students may substitute a course for a required course either as described below for C675 or with the approval of their minor advisor.

Required courses

C750	Learning and Teaching on the College Campus	3 credits
C750	Curriculum in Higher Education	3 credits
C675	Supervised College Teaching	3 credits

Students who take a course on teaching or a teaching practicum within their home department do not need to take C675.

Elective courses

9-Credit Minor—If all three required courses are taken, no elective courses are needed. If a student does not need to take C675, the student needs to take one elective course.

12-Credit Minor— If all three required courses are taken, one elective course is needed. If a student does not need to take C675, the student needs to take two elective courses.

A list of example elective courses is available from the HESA program. Students may not count courses taken in their major toward their minor.

Minor qualifying exam

A minor qualifying exam is not required for this minor.
