## Q4 Did you actively seek employment after graduation as a school counselor or a related occupation?





#### Q9 Do you currently receive supervision for your counseling work?





#### Q13 How often did you meet with your advisor during your studies?





### Q29 The faculty supervisors for field experience courses and group supervision





#### Q30 The instructional classroom (i.e., effectiveness)




