
### Q13 How often did you meet with your advisor during your studies?




### Q27 The sites available for supervised field experiences








### Q29 The faculty supervisors for field experience courses and group supervision


### Q30 The instructional classroom (i.e., effectiveness)


### Q31 The professional competence of the program faculty










