

**IUPUI School of Education
Employment Data**

Each year the IUPUI Department of Instructional Research & Decision Support conducts a destination survey of recent graduates for the entire university. Below are the data from this survey addressing “Career Outcome” for the School of Education graduates. Because the N for the secondary programs were not available for some years, the aggregated data from 2016-2021 are provided. Earlier surveys gave respondents an opportunity to select “part-time employment” but this option was later removed from the survey. Years where the option was available, the percentage of respondents selecting this option is provided in the employment category. The percentages in the last column are in relationship to only the number of responded who were employed full-time and reflection education major who were employed full-time in the field of education.
