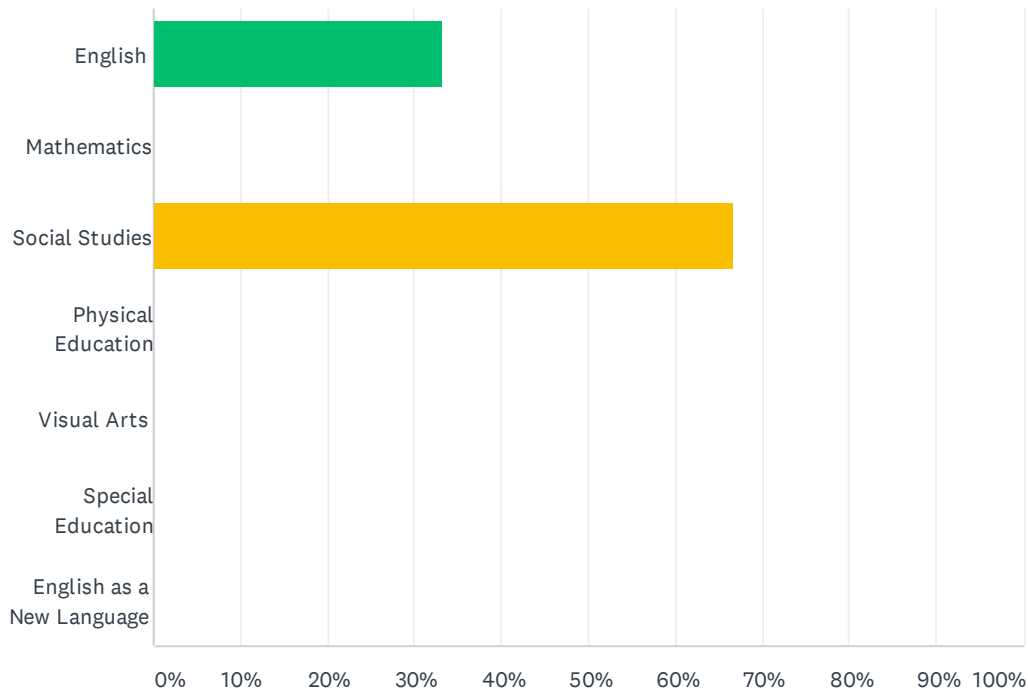


Q1 What teacher education program did you complete? Select all that apply

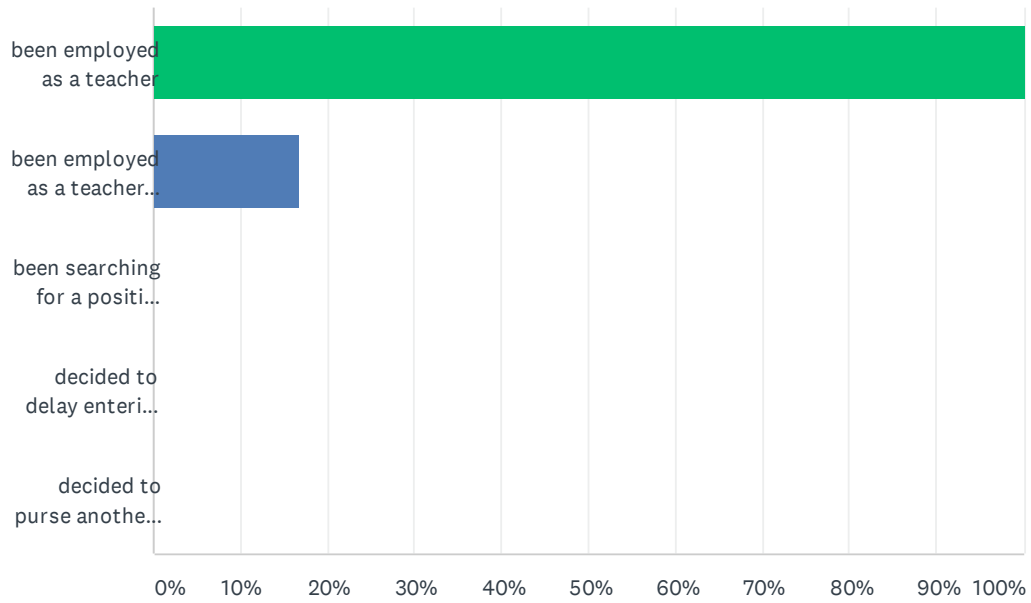

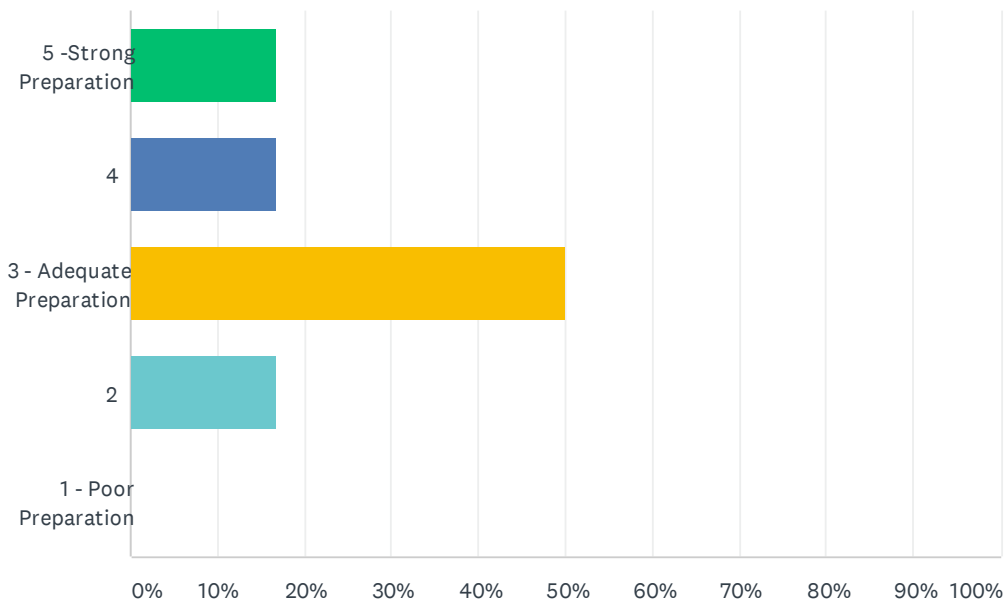

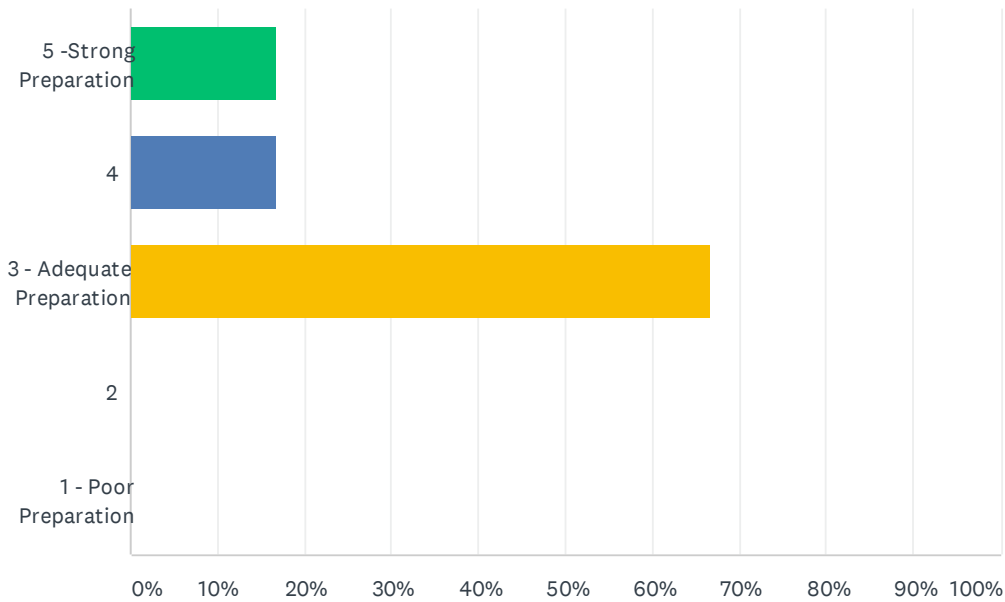

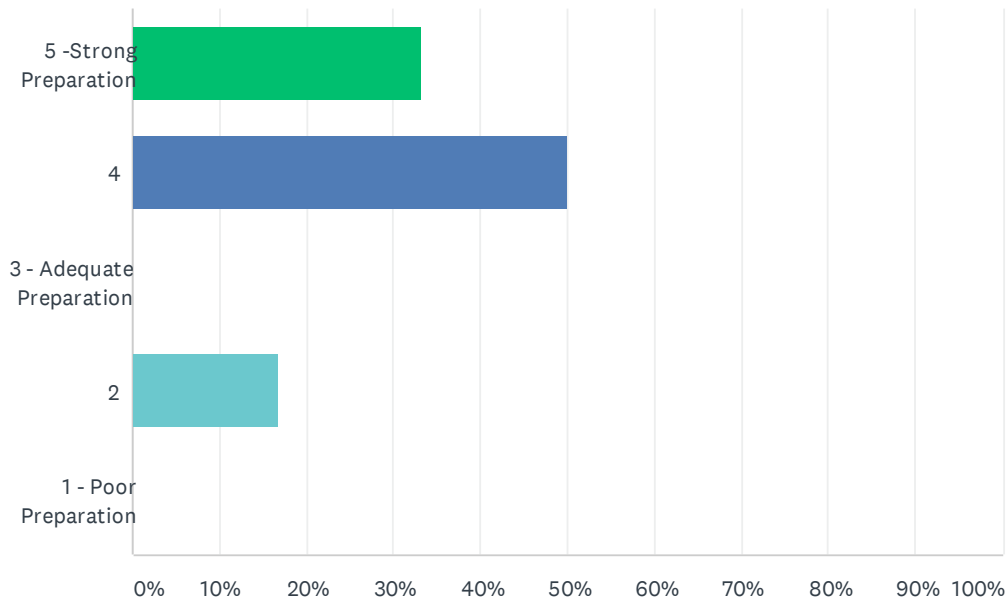

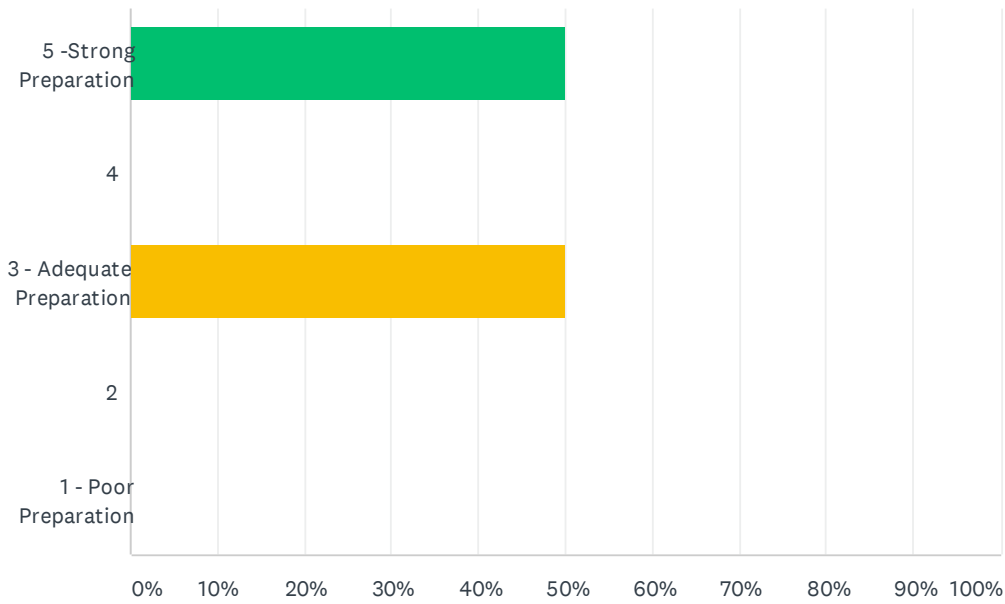

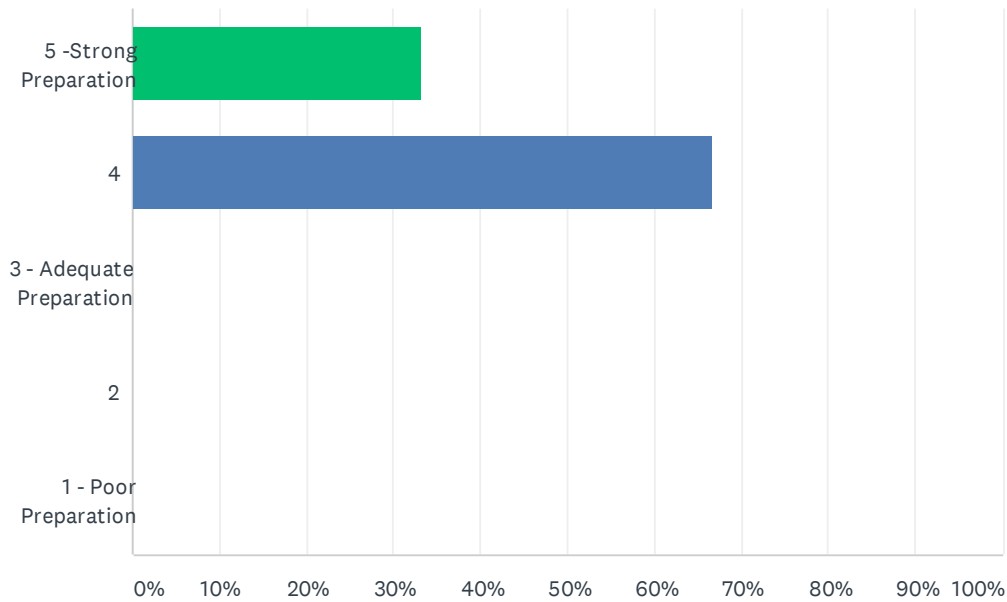

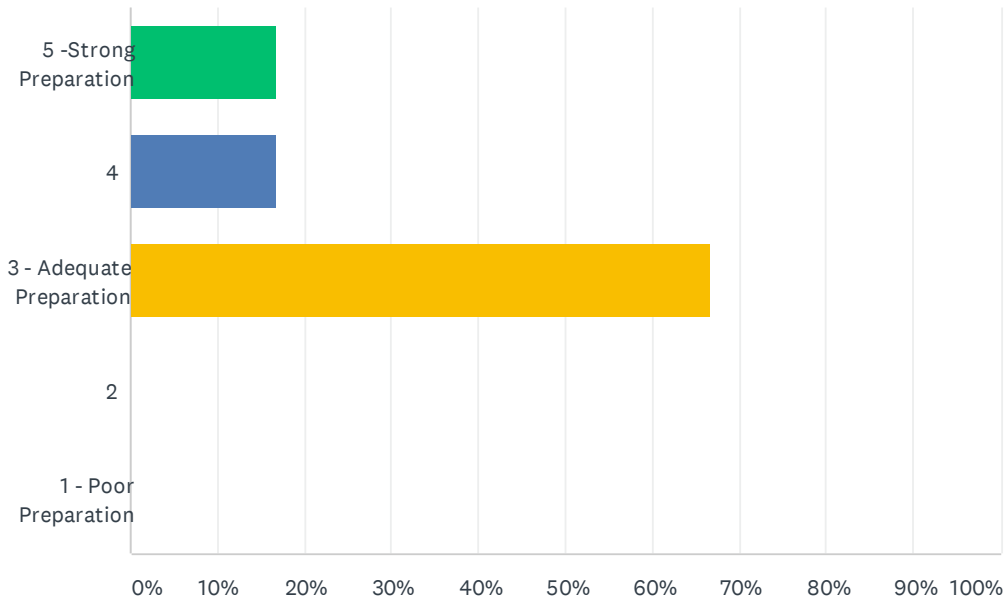

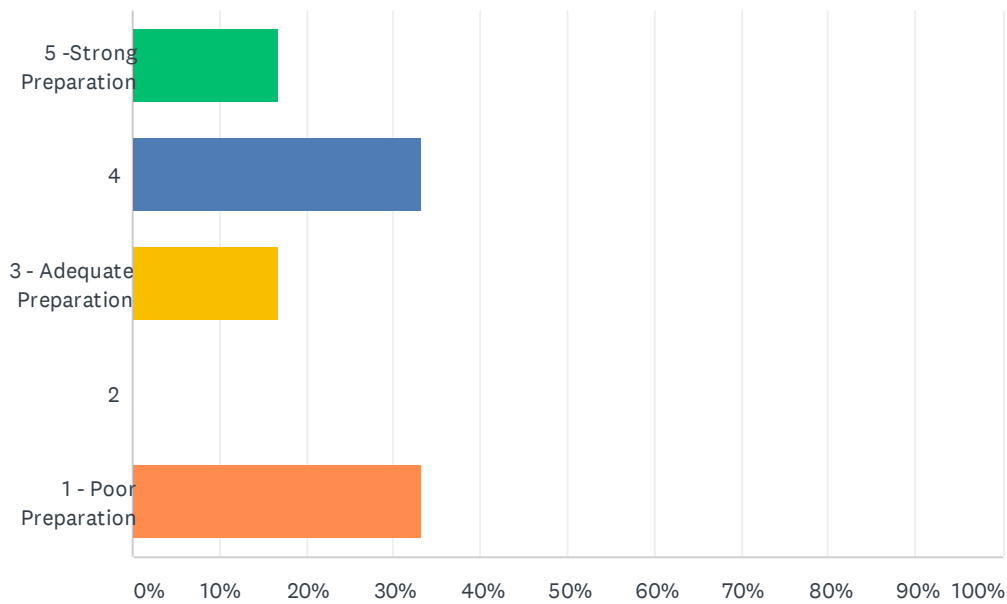

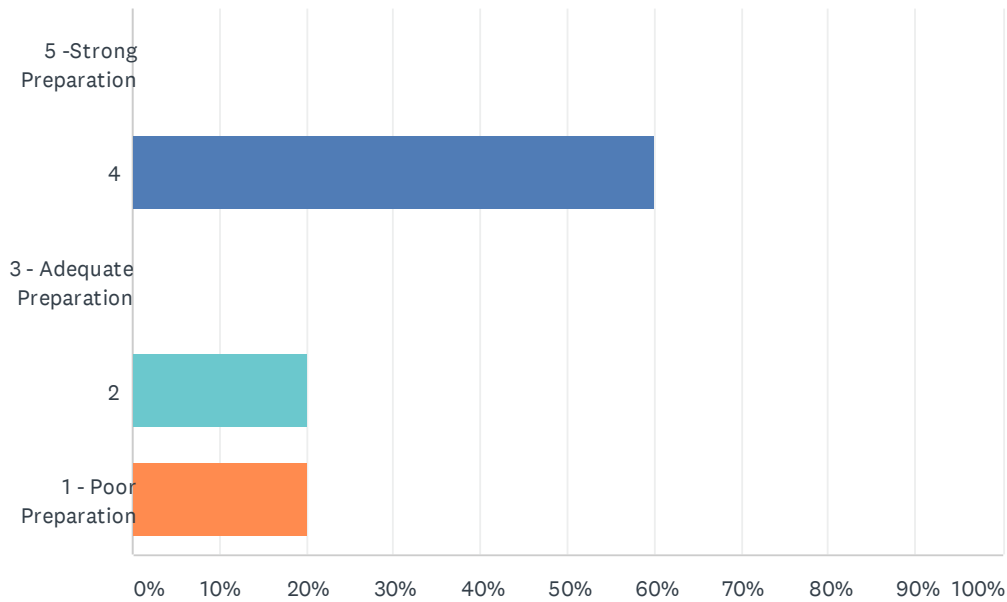

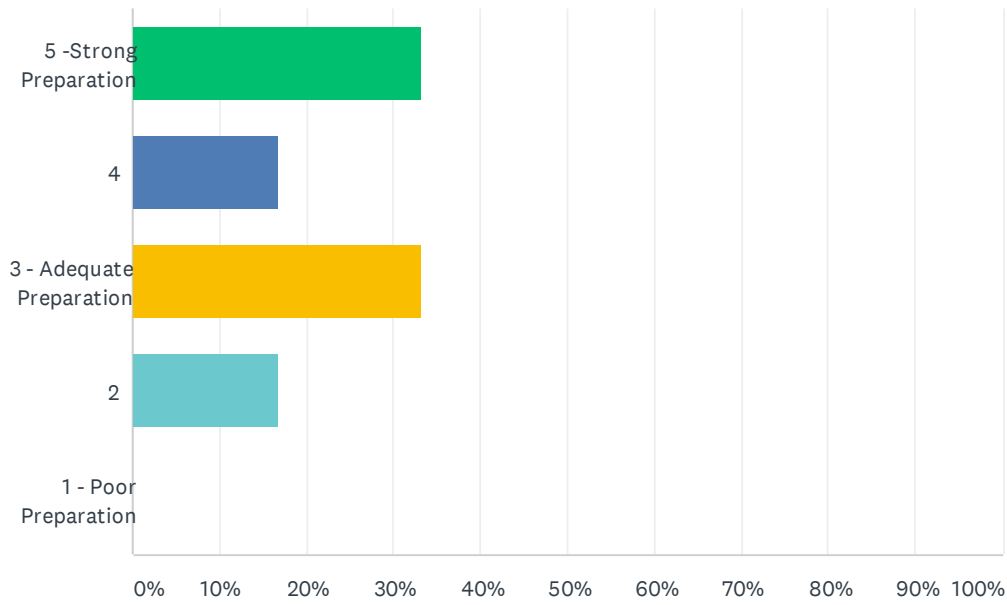

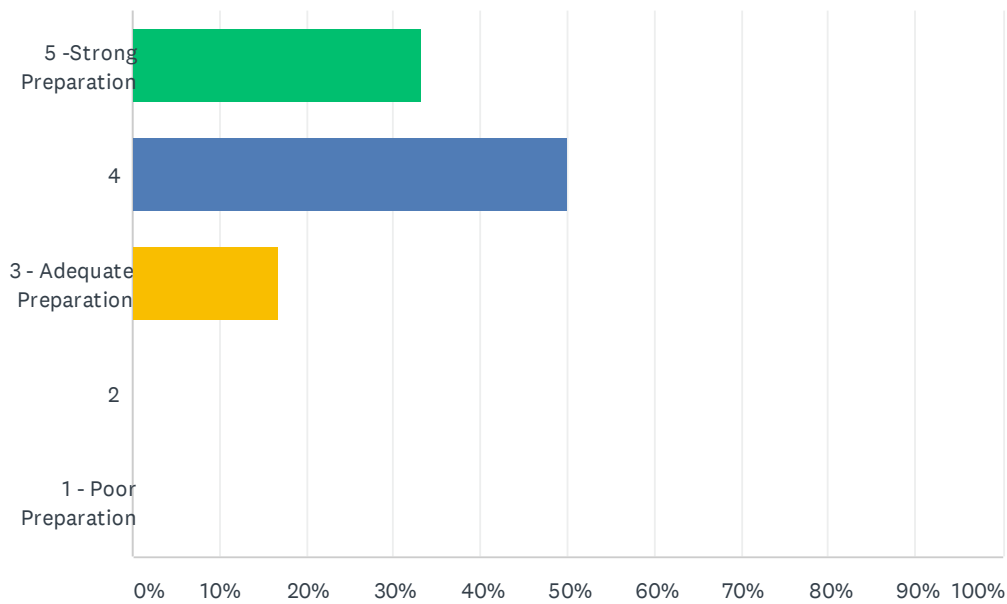

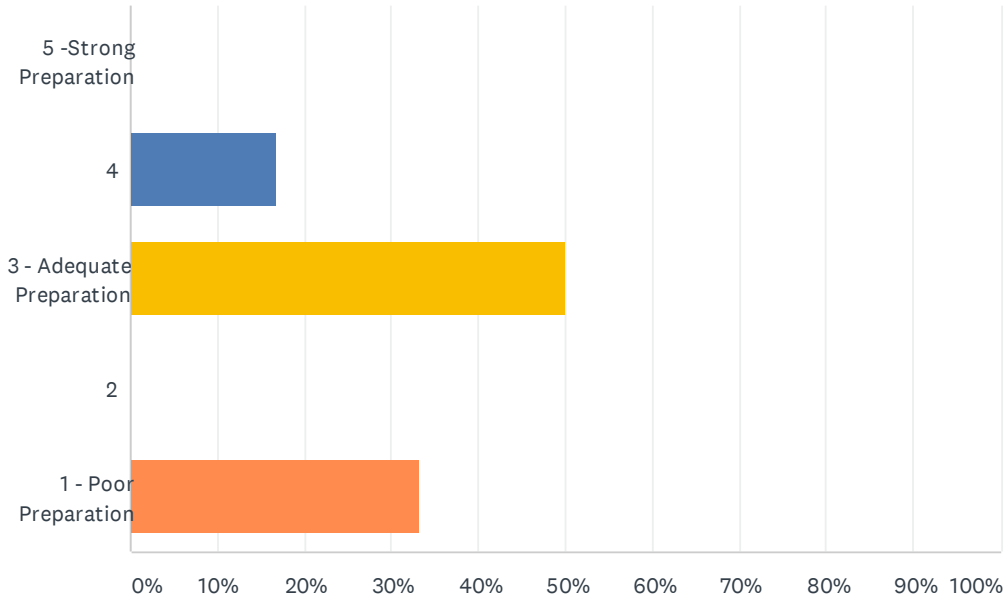

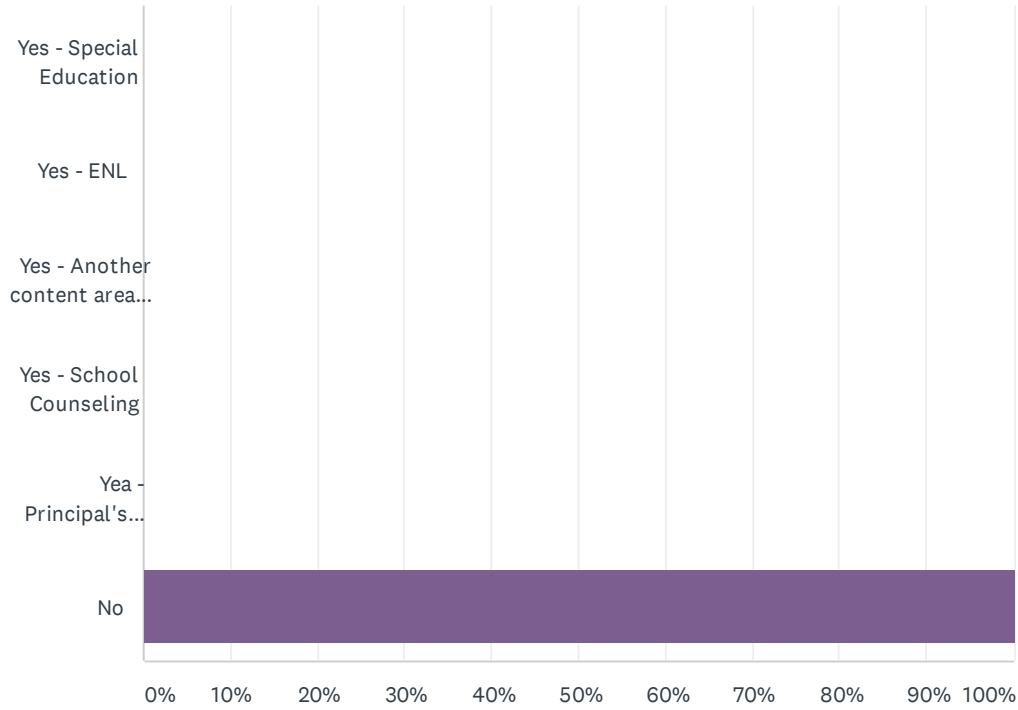
