New Courses

L239 Language and Learning 3 credits Bloomington/IUPUI
Examines the role of language in creating, maintaining, and changing educational practices.

Topics include bilingualism, dialects, heritage languages, language-in-education policy, language revitalization, and first and second language learning. Other topics include basic linguistic principles that are useful for pedagogy in both formal and non-formal contexts.
