

Proposal

We are proposing to add flexibility in foundational and elective courses in IUPUI's K12 principal leadership track in the masters degree as outlined below. These adjustments will allow the program to pair educational leadership programs with certificates that are moving to approval such as certificates in Urban Education Advocacy, Inclusive Special Education, English as a Second Language, Literacy and Learning, etc. The specific modifications to the program of study for the two tracks are as follows (programs of study are attached):

K12 Principal leadership Track: We propose 1) to reduce the “foundations”* requirement from 9 credit hours to six hours; 2) to add additional offerings in the “foundations” area (e.g. T531, A560, K505, L500); and 3) to increase elective coursework from 3 credit hours to 6.

*We note that the term “foundations” in the program of study does not refer specifically to courses in the ELPS Foundations program area as the current program includes courses in Educational Psychology. Consistent with that, we'll propose course offerings in this area that would provide a strong foundation for the principalship program.
